

ADMISSION NOTICE FOR THE VFA TRAINING COURSE
SESSION: 2024-25

In pursuance of approval of the Govt. of Assam vide Letter No. E-613214/18 dated 31/05/2025, **ONLINE APPLICATIONS** are invited from eligible intending candidates permanently residing in **Assam** for undergoing one year **VFA Training Course** in Elementary Knowledge of A.H. & Veterinary Science for the Session 2024-25 at the School of Veterinary Science& A.H. at Ghungoor, Silchar, Assam and its extended campuses **which will be received from 12.00 hrs of 14/06/2025 up to 23.59hrs of 13/07/2025** for admission against 200 number of seats against 200 nos of vacancies as per Roster Register as mentioned hereunder:

B. Age: A candidate should not be less than 18 years and should not be more than 30 years of age as on 01/01/2025. The upper age limit is relaxable for the candidates of reserved categories as per the existing provision. However, there is no provision for condonation of age. Age Relaxation: Upper age limit is relaxable as under:

- i. 03 (three) years in case of candidates belonging to OBC/MOBC.
- ii. 05 (five) years in case of candidates belonging to SC, ST (P) &ST (H)

For determining the age limit, the Department will accept only the date of birth recorded in the Matriculation or equivalent examination Certificate/Admit card issued by a recognized Education Board. No other document relating to age such as horoscope, affidavit, birth extract from Municipal Corporation, Health Department, Service record etc. will be accepted.

C. Educational Qualifications:

Minimum educational qualification required for admission is HSSLC (Science) passed with Biology as aSubject from the recognized University/ Board as perRule 8 of “The Assam Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Subordinate Service Rule,2002” as amended up to date vide “TheAssam Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Subordinate Service (Amendment) Rules, 2017” published vide Govt. NotificationNo.VFV.155/2013/62 dated06/07/2017.

D. Application Fees: There will be no application fee for all the categories of candidates.

E. Reservation:

Reservation for admission into 200 seats shall be given as per the existing Reservation Policy. The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of the latest income certificate for the Financial Year 2024-25 issued by the Circle Officer of the Revenue Circle where the candidate and/or his family normally resides. The income and asset certificate issued by any one of the authorities in the prescribed format given in Annexure-1(to be uploaded in the Department’s website) shall only be accepted as proof of the candidate’s claim as belonging to EWS.

F. How to Apply:-

- Candidates who have the required essential qualification for the proposed training course as mentioned above may apply by submitting online application through the official website (**ahvfa.assam.gov.in**) **The link will be available from 12.00 hrs. of 14th June, 2025 to 23.59 hrs of 13th July, 2025.**The prescribed Online application shall have to be duly filled up and submitted online along with scanned copy of documents listed at Serial No. Hhereunder of thisAdmission Notice.
- Before applying online, candidates are advised to go through carefully the instructions provided in this Notice as well as on the website.
- No MANUAL Application FORM will be accepted.

G. Selection Procedure:

As approved by the Government of Assam the following procedure is followed in selection of candidates for admission into the one-year VFA Training Course.

- (i) After thorough scrutiny of applications, eligible candidates are called for Personnel Assessment Test (PAT) of 100 marks as shown below:
 - (a) Percentage of marks in HSSLC Sc with Biology - 40% weightage
 - (b) Percentage of marks in HSLC - 20% weightage
 - (c) Personnel Assessment Test (PAT) - 40% weightage
- (ii) Questions are asked about Biology, Physics, Chemistry and General Awareness of state & national importance. Five questions are asked by each member of the Selection Board consisting of 2/3 members daily on a rotational basis. Each question carries 4 marks.
- (iv) Final merit List is prepared according to total marks obtained (a+b+c) subject to observance of reservation policy.

H. Last date of Online Application:

Deadline of Online Application Submission is 23.59 hours of 13 th July 2025.

I. Documents to be uploaded:

- For age proof, HSLC Certificate or Admit Card issued by recognized Board/Council.
- The PRC (Permanent Resident Certificate) issued for Educational Purposeor Receipt of Application for PRCbefore the DeputyCommissioner’s Office.
- HSLC (or equivalent) Marksheet
- HSSLC (Sc.) Marksheet.
- Recent Passport Size Photograph.
- Scanned Copy of Signature of the Candidate.
- Caste Certificate/EWS Certificate (For the Financial year 2024-25) from competent authority If applying for such category.
- DDO’s Certificate in case of serving Grade-IV employees of the Department.

J. Other Terms & Conditions

- Candidates must be permanent residents of the State of Assam and are required to uploads scanned copy of the Permanent Resident Certificate(PRC) along with the Online Application. If a candidate fails to upload PRC at the time of submission of Application, receipt of Application for Application for PRC submitted before the Deputy Commissioner’s office may be submitted but at the time of Personality Assessment Test, the original copy of certificate should be produced, failure of which the candidature may be rejected outright.
- Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected.
- The candidates whose applications are found complete in all respects and accepted online will be called for personnel assessment test before the Selection Committee. The candidates will have to produce all original certificates and testimonials before the Selection Committee at the time of the personnel assessment test.
- The date of personnel assessment test (PAT) will be notified in due course of time.
- The eligible candidates will have to appear for personnel assessment test before the selection committee to be held at the Office of the Director,Animal Husbandry & Veterinary, Assam,Chenikuthi,Guwahati-781003.
- No TA/DA will be admissible for appearing for the Personnel Assessment Test.
- Canvassing either directly or indirectly will disqualify the candidate
- The list of eligible candidates will be uploaded in the Department’s website and also be displayed in the Office Notice Board of the Directorate of A.H. & VeterinaryDeptt., Guwahati-3 and the Principal, School of Veterinary Science & A.H. at Ghungoor, Silchar, Assam.
- The Roll Numbers of the selected candidates(Final Results)may also be notified through leading English Newspaper Published from Guwahati, Assam.
- The selected candidates will have to execute a bond before joining the course.
- The authority reserves the right to arrange the training course at any other campus within the State of Assam.

- Subject to availability of vacancy and observance of Rules & Regulations, the successful trainees may be appointed from time to time. However, the authority shall not be bound to provide appointment/jobs on completion of the course.
- The candidate selected for admission will have to produce physical fitness certificates from the District/Sub-Divisional Medical and Health Officers.

K. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES: -

- The selection list confers no right to admission into the VFA Training Course unless the department is satisfied with the suitability of the candidate after a thorough medical examination and verification of all essential documents for eligibility as may be considered necessary before admission to the Course.
- Candidature will be summarily rejected at any stage of the selection process, if found not conforming to the official format/submitting incomplete information/wrong information/ incomplete requisite certificate(s)/misrepresentation of facts impersonation.
- The Department reserves the right to make changes or cancel or postpone the selection process on specific grounds.
- Fake documents / false information/misrepresentation of facts shall lead to rejection if detected at any stage before/after admission and shall make the candidate liable to criminal proceeding as per existing law.
- Offering a bribe or any favour by a candidate or by any individual on behalf of any candidate is a criminal offence. Such an activity shall result in immediate disqualification of the candidate’s candidature.
- Candidates should mention their full/proper address with PIN Code.
- In case of any confusion, the decision of the Department will be final.
- The Rules &Regulations, terms & conditions of the department will be applicable.
- Details of Documents to be scanned& uploaded as per Clause G above:

a) Passport size photograph: -

- Only good quality photographs must be uploaded. Poor quality photograph uploaded will lead to rejection of your application. The admit card will be printed with the photograph you uploaded.
- i) The photograph must be in colour and in a white background.
 - ii) The photograph must have been taken after 1st January, 2025.
 - iii) Face should occupy about 50% of the area in the photograph, and with a full face view looking into the camera directly.
 - iv) The main features of the face must not be covered by hair of the head, any cloth or any shadow. Forehead, both eyes, nose, cheek, lip and chin should be clearly visible.
 - v) If a candidate normally wears spectacles, glare on glasses is not acceptable in photograph. Glare can be avoided with a slight downward tilt of the glasses for the photo shoot.
 - vi) Candidates must not wear spectacles with dark or tinted glasses, only clear glasses are permitted.
 - vii) Image should be in a JPEG format and on a standard 4.5cm x 3.5cm (45mm x 35mm) print.
 - viii) Maximum pixel resolution for JPEG: 150 (W) x 200 (H) (Studio may be advised to reduce it to this resolution if it is higher.
 - ix) The file size should be200 - 500 kb (kilo bytes).
 - x) For the candidate’s own benefit, it may be prudent not to intentionally change his/her facial features or hair style from what is seen in the photograph until the day of the Personality Assessment Test (PAT).

b) Signature: -

- i) The signature should be put with black or dark blue ink on white paper.
 - ii) Only the JPEG image format will be accepted.
 - iii) The maximum pixel resolution for the image is150 (W) x 200 (H)
 - iv) Dimension of signature image should be 150 (width) x 50 (height) pixels
 - v) The file size should be 30 - 100 kb (kilo bytes).
- The candidates after duly filling up the Online Application and uploading the required documents as mentioned herein above will be directed to payment gateway for payment of fees. Subject to duly filling up the Application, uploading of documents and successful payment of fees theApplication would get submitted.
 - The candidates can then download the registration/application slip with Registration No/ Enrollment IDNumber.
 - It is mandatory for the candidates to mention their full/proper address with the correct PIN Code, a valid email address and active mobile phone number in the application form as the same will be used to inform them regarding the status of their applications and convey other related information.
 - A candidate whose application is found to be in order will be called forth the Personality Assessment Test(PAT).
 - The Department will not be responsible for any discrepancies that may arise due to entry of wrong mobile number and email address by the candidate.
 - Incomplete / defective / invalid application will be summarily rejected.
 - The candidates who are employees of the Govt. / PSUs / Autonomous bodies should inform to their authorities about the application made and necessary copy of NOC from the competent authority / employer should be produced during scrutiny of documents on the day of Personality Assessment Test.

L. Call Letter Downloading

The eligible candidates will have to download Call Letter from the Department’s website by entering their Mobile No. and Password/Enrollment ID number for Personality Assessment Test which will be communicated later.

M. SCRUTINY OF DOCUMENTS: -

Candidates will be required to carry original Documents/Testimonials when appearing for the Personality assessment test for scrutiny by the authority. Candidates failing to bring the originals will not be considered for such qualifications as claimed by him/her and no further rectifications will be entertained after the Personality assessment test.

N. TESTIMONIALS/DOCUMENTS IN ORIGINAL TO BE PRODUCED when appearing for PERSONNEL ASSESSMENT TEST.

- Identity proof like Pan Card/Driving License/Passport/Current ID Card issued by Educational Institutions/Voter ID Card/AADHAR Card (anyone) along with the Call Letter.
- Certificate of proof of age. (Admit card/Pass Certificate of HSLC or equivalent examination)
- Certificate & Mark sheet of HSSLC (Sc.) with Biology.
- Certificate of Caste from the competent authority in respect of the candidates belonging to OBC/MOBC, SC, ST (P) & ST (H).
- Duly signed Annexure-1, Annexure-2 & Annexure-3(whenever applicable).
- EWS certificate from Competent Authority by EWS candidates (whenever applicable).
- 2 (two) copies of recent passport size photographs taken after 01/01/2025.

O. MERIT LIST:-

Based on the aggregate performance of the candidates in the Personality Assessment Test the Final Merit listwill be prepared category wise against 200nos of seats as shown in the advertisement.

There will be only ONE merit list category wise i.e. General, OBC/MOBC, SC, ST(P), ST(H)& EWS separately against 200 seats.

N. B:

- i. In case of a tie in marks, the candidate older in age will be placed higher in the merit list
- ii. Further, candidates having same date of birth and have obtained equal marks, the candidate scoring higher marks in the minimum essential qualification (HSSLC Sc.) for the post will be placed higher in the merit list.
- iii. In case seats reserved for EWS are not filled up by candidates belonging to EWS category during the selection process due to shortage of eligible candidates, the balance posts will be filled up from candidates of unreserved category.
